The Rosemount Double Dutch Club is a demonstration team that practices twice a week for 6 months of the school year. The second session fee of \$45 is due to cover Monday and Wednesday classes (and two Tuesday classes) in December and January.

The American Heart Association has sponsored the Club since 2009. Club Kids demonstrate their rope jumping skills at other schools to promote this heart healthy activity and to kick off AHA jump rope for heart fundraisers. The plan is to take approximately 24 students along on each demonstration day. Some students will participate in more demonstrations than others so that all of the skills in the program can be covered.

Because there are an unusually high number of students in the Club (51), I have asked AHA to provide 25 free t-shirts and we will be able to purchase the remainder.
