VocalMotion (grades 2-5)

Learn the art of vocal performance and dance, and develop skills in three major areas:

Voice and Vocal Performance

Learn to work as a soloist and an ensemble member, focusing on pitch, posture, facial expression, physicality and other vocal skills.

Dance and Movement

Through movement games and exercises, learn to express yourself through dance. Focus on technique, rhythmic acuity and stage presence.

Ensemble Performance

Work together on a musical and dance presentation.

Each day of camp includes activity sessions in all areas and opportunities for dramatic improvisation.
