

Special Nutrition Needs

The Food and Nutrition Services Manager will make a reasonable attempt to keep the food your child eats for school meals within his/her dietary restrictions, however, food products may be substituted by the vendor/USDA. Ingredients in the substitutions may be different and our ingredient data cannot be 100 percent accurate.

Special diet requests will be reviewed and evaluated on a case-by-case basis. For special diet requests, it may take up to two weeks for the Food and Nutrition Services office to comply with the specific food items for your child.

Any change to the student's diet must be verified by a new Special Diet Statement from a licensed physician.

- Special Diet Statement submitted
- Cycle menu plan reviewed
- Reviewed list of food items on the menu along with their corresponding ingredient labels
- Parent has reviewed or agreed to review the special/medically prescribed diet with their child regarding food and menu choices
