Who Should Attend?

This program is for children who are enrolled to begin kindergarten in District 196 this September. Classes are held August 14-17, at all of the district's elementary schools.

Bridge to School is designed for children to ease transition into kindergarten. Students will become familiar with their new school environment, teaching staff, classmates and routines of the day. Parents are encouraged to join their child on August 14 for the first hour and a half for interaction and an information session on successfully parenting your kindergartner. Placements are made until capacity is reached. Waitlists will be created and every effort to add sections will be made.

Transportation

Transportation is available to the elementary school based on your attendance area. **Busing to magnet or open enrollment schools outside your attendance area is NOT available.** Bus schedule information will be sent to families just prior to the start of Bridge to School and will not necessarily align to the school year bus stop. If you live less than one mile from the school your child may be designated as a walker. Registration must be received by April 21 in order to be included in the initial transportation scheduling.

Tuition

The full tuition for this program is \$75. Partial tuition assistance is available only for families unable to pay the full fee. If full tuition assistance is needed, call 952-388-1953 and have your approximate annual family income available when calling. Payment is made when registering online or by check/credit card if mailing registration.

Meals

Food & Nutrition Services will be serving a healthy snack daily. Students with food restrictions may choose to bring a healthy snack from home.
