4. Parent Leader Superintendent Report – Tracy Monro Moran
 - Mr. Currie shared that 3,600 people have filled out the district survey so far. The survey will be available through November 8th. *Preliminary* results indicate people are in favor of:
 - Later start time for high schoolers
 - Spanish in elementary schools
 - Starting school in August to be done in June
 - A shorter winter break
 - Not having year-round school
 - Not having a week off in October
 - Moving the first conference later in the school year
 - Assigning a week in March for spring vacation
 - The district office will be moving to its new location approximately March 1st.
5. Principal's Report
 - Parents/guardians are encouraged to voice their opinion by filling out the district survey (available on line until November 8th).
 - A Parenting Conference will be held at EVHS on November 8th.
 - Conference attendance was down from last winter's attendance. Of the 68 conferences that had to be rescheduled, 40 were due to family vacations.
