Koolaid Playdoh

2 1/2 cups flour
1/2 cup salt
2 packages dry unsweetened koolaid
2 cups boiling water
3 Tablespoons cooking oil

Mix dry ingredients together in bowl. Mix liquids together and pour into dry ingredients. Stir until it forms a ball. At first it will appear as if it will never make a smooth playdoh mixture. As the mixture cools and becomes less sticky, take it out of the bowl and knead until smooth.

Cooked Playdoh

In a saucepan combine:
1 cup flour
1/2 cup salt
2 teaspoons of cream of tartar

Add:
1 cup water
1 Tablespoon cooking oil
food coloring

Combine ingredients and stir until well blended. Place pan over medium heat and cook until mixture forms into a ball (about 3 minutes). Put dough on waxed paper or on counter and knead until smooth. Store in air tight container in refrigerator.

Lotion Playdoh

1 cup flour
2 T cream of tartar
1/2 cup salt
1 T hand lotion
1 T oil
1 cup boiling water
food coloring

Put food coloring into boiling water. Add to other ingredients. Mix with spoon and then with hands. Store in airtight container in refrigerator.

Glurch

1 cup Elmer's School Glue
1 cup liquid starch

Pour glue into ice cream pail and then add starch. Stir ingredients and then knead the mixture with your hands. Allowing the mixture to sit for a while will help to get a better result. If it is too runny - add more glue. If it is too sticky - add more starch. Store in a closed container in refrigerator.
