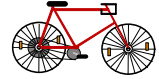
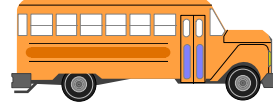


Safety First

Transportation Tips for the 2009-2010 School Year



The following is a list of tips we encourage all EVHS students and their parents to follow:

1. Carpool within your neighborhood.
2. Add 15 extra minutes to your morning schedule so you don't get detention for tardies.
3. Follow our drop off and pick up directions (please turn over).
4. Drive slowly in all neighborhoods and EVHS parking lots due to the increased number of walkers.

Walkers:

1. Cross only at crosswalks or streetlights.
2. Be aware of cars that are going too fast.
3. Walk only on sidewalks and use crosswalks in the parking lot.
4. Dress for the elements.

Students driving to school:

1. Use the lottery method to receive a parking permit (\$90 per semester-see the enclosed information) or purchase a daily permit (\$4.00 per day).
2. Park in the Teen Center lot (free parking and close walking).
3. Carpool within your neighborhood.
4. Add 15 extra minutes to your morning schedule so you don't get detention for tardies.
5. Drive slowly in all neighborhoods and EVHS parking lots due to the increased number of walkers.
6. **STOP AT ALL CROSSWALKS – PEDESTRIANS HAVE THE RIGHT-OF-WAY.**

Parent Dropping-off or Picking-up:

1. Carpool within your neighborhood.
2. Add 15 extra minutes to your morning schedule.
3. Drive slowly in all neighborhoods and EVHS parking lots due to the increased number of walkers.
4. Drop off students along the outside sidewalks (see map on back of this flier).
5. Pick up students at EVHS in the bus corral AFTER 2:45 (that way we can get the 500 student cars out of the parking lots before you arrive).
6. **STOP AT ALL CROSSWALKS – PEDESTRIANS HAVE THE RIGHT-OF-WAY.**
7. Please note the North Lot is one-way traffic.
