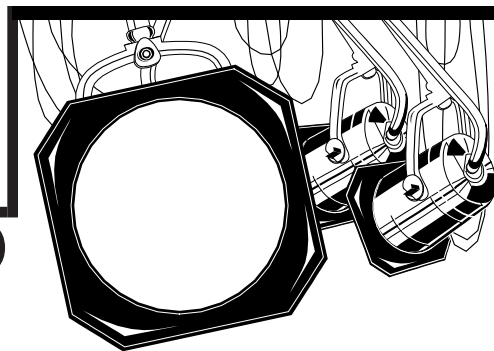


Hit the Lights!

Junior Thespians:
Entering Grades 1-5

Each day during this camp, students will work to develop their skills in three major performance areas: vocal performance, dance, and acting.

Vocal Performance:
Working closely with a talented teacher, performers focus on developing the skills of singing with a group, learning musical theatre songs, and becoming comfortable with their voice.

Dance:
Performers will learn a variety of basic steps of movement and dance for a portion of each day. Dance moves will focus on coordination, basic combinations, and having fun!

Acting:
Through a progression of theatre games, students will develop the skills of the stage. Vocal clarity and projection, sustained attention and focus, eye contact, and stage movement all form the basis from which a solid performance can be built.

Students engaged in this camp will have an opportunity to develop the skills necessary to be successful in a high school theatre program. Introductory lessons in acting, stage movement, technical theatre, and dance will comprise this advanced course. Character development, script analysis, improvisation, vocal development for the stage, line memorization techniques, theatrical painting, scenic lighting, and dancing for the theatre are among the skills that will be developed. Students in this camp will have an opportunity to work closely with the directors in the Eastview Theatre Department and have fun developing the skills to excel in a theatrical setting.
