Dear Parent:

Greetings from Rosemount High School! The start of the 2009-2010 school year is quickly approaching. The purpose of this mailing is to provide you with an opportunity to review your son's/daughter's 2009-2010 academic schedule(s) and communicate information in preparation for the new school year.

2009-2010 Student Schedules

Enclosed are copies of your son's/daughter's individual trimester schedules for the upcoming school year. Please review the schedules carefully. Student schedules have been built based on the course requests that were made during the winter registration process. Fall schedules with locker numbers and combinations will be distributed in homeroom on the first day of school.

During the past school year, students were urged to register for 2009–2010 classes with great care. Based on student registrations, a master schedule of classes has been developed and teachers have been hired. Because of this, schedule adjustments are allowed only if seats are available and the request meets one or more of the Schedule Review criteria. These criteria are found on page ii of the 2009-2010 Rosemount High School Registration Guide – which can be found at (<http://www.district196.org/rhs/academics/regguide0910/intro.pdf>).

If a student wishes to request a schedule adjustment, they must complete a *T1 Schedule Adjustment Form* during “Fall Schedule Review Week”. These forms are available in the Guidance Office during Fall Schedule Review Week which runs from 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 18, 2009 through noon on Wednesday, August 26, 2009. The Guidance Office will be open from 8:00 a.m. through 3:00 p.m. during Fall Schedule Review Week. Students will be notified by phone if their schedule adjustment request has been denied. Approved adjustment requests will be reflected on the student's schedule which they will receive in homeroom on the first day of school.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Modified First Day Of School

The schedule for the first day of school on Tuesday, September 8 will be modified in an attempt to provide a positive transition experience for our ninth grade students. Ninth grade students will put in a full day of school on September 8. Students in grades 10 – 12 will begin school at 11:00 a.m. and only participate in a half day of school. Details regarding the first day of school and where students should report are included on the “First Day of School Flyer” which is included in this mailing. A morning study hall will be available in the Student Center for students in grades 10 – 12 who do not have an alternative mode of transportation and need to ride the bus to school.
