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Dear Parent:

Greetings from Rosemount High School! The start of the 2017-2018 school year is quickly approaching. The purpose of this mailing is to communicate information in preparation for the new school year.

## 2017-2018 Student Schedules

A preliminary draft (subject to change) of your son's/daughter's individual trimester schedules for the upcoming school year will be posted in ParentVUE by August 14<sup>th</sup>. Please review the schedules carefully. Student schedules have been built based on the course requests that were made during the winter registration process. Official Fall schedules will be distributed in homeroom on the first day of school.

During the past school year, students were urged to register for 2017-2018 classes with great care. Based on student registrations, a master schedule of classes has been developed and teachers have been hired. Because of this, schedule adjustments are allowed only if seats are available and the request meets one or more of the Schedule Review criteria. These criteria are found on page ii of the 2017-2018 Rosemount High School Registration Guide at [www.district196.org/rhs/academics/regguide1718/intro.pdf](http://www.district196.org/rhs/academics/regguide1718/intro.pdf).

If a student wishes to request a schedule adjustment, they must complete a *T1 Schedule Adjustment Form* during "Fall Schedule Review Week". Fall Schedule Review Week will begin Monday, August 14, 2017 and end Friday, August 18, 2017. Beginning August 14<sup>th</sup>, students can print an online form at [www.district196.org/rhs/forms](http://www.district196.org/rhs/forms) or pick up a form in the main office. Completed forms should be dropped off in the main office by August 18<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm. Requests will be processed prior to the first day of school. Students will be called at home if the request cannot be granted. Approved adjustment requests will be reflected on the student's schedule which they will receive in homeroom on the first day of school.

Ninth grade students will put in a full day of school on September 5. Students in grades 10 – 12 will begin school at 11:00 a.m. and only participate in a half day of school. On the first day of school busses will run at their normal time. A morning study hall will be available in the Student Center for students in grades 10 – 12 who do not have an alternative mode of transportation and need to ride the bus to school. **School doors for students in grades 10-12 will open at 10:50 a.m.**
