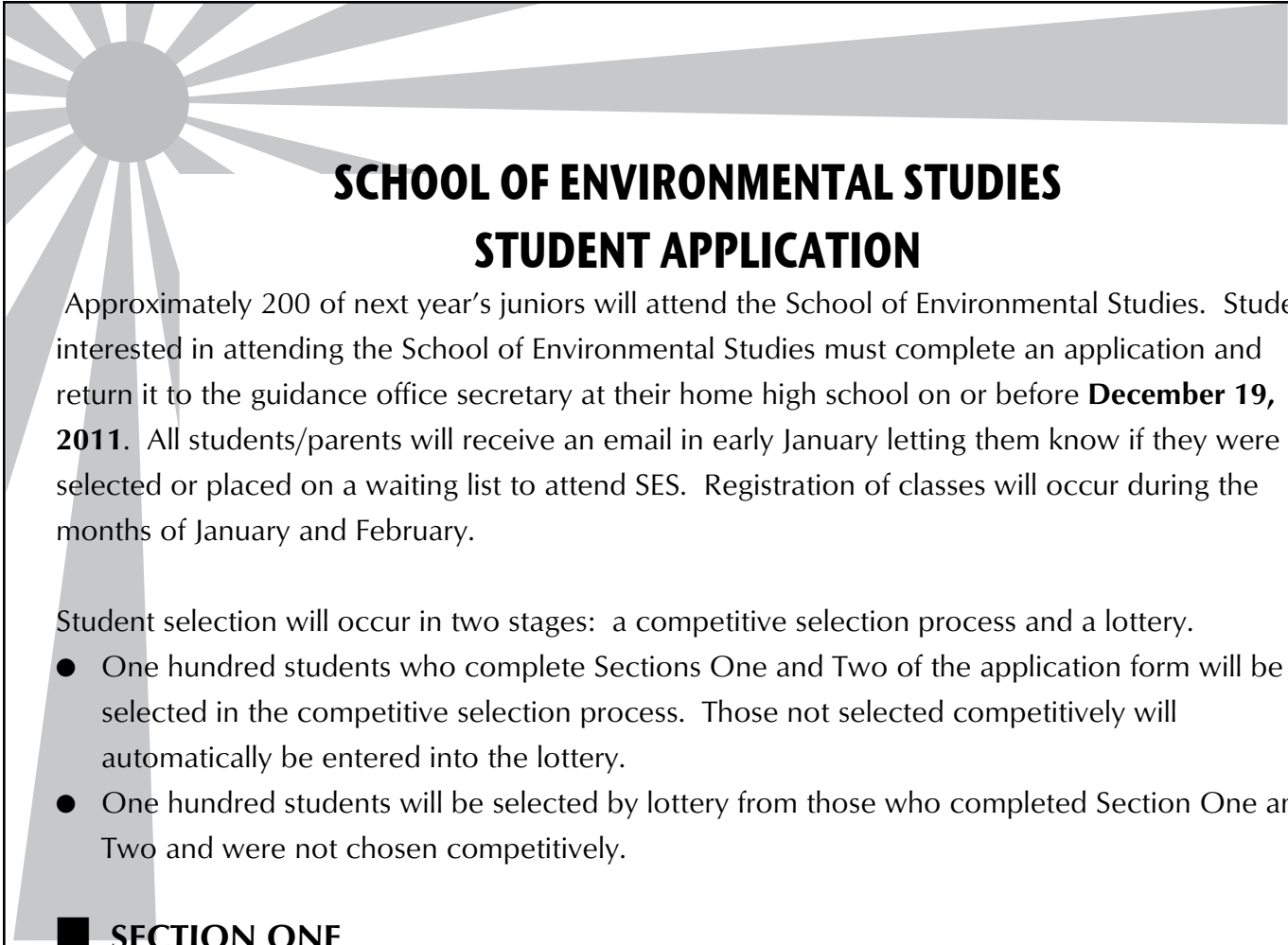

STUDENT APPLICATION

Approximately 200 of next year's juniors will attend the School of Environmental Studies. Students interested in attending the School of Environmental Studies must complete an application and return it to the guidance office secretary at their home high school on or before **December 19, 2011**. All students/parents will receive an email in early January letting them know if they were selected or placed on a waiting list to attend SES. Registration of classes will occur during the months of January and February.

Student selection will occur in two stages: a competitive selection process and a lottery.

- One hundred students who complete Sections One and Two of the application form will be selected in the competitive selection process. Those not selected competitively will automatically be entered into the lottery.
- One hundred students will be selected by lottery from those who completed Section One and Two and were not chosen competitively.

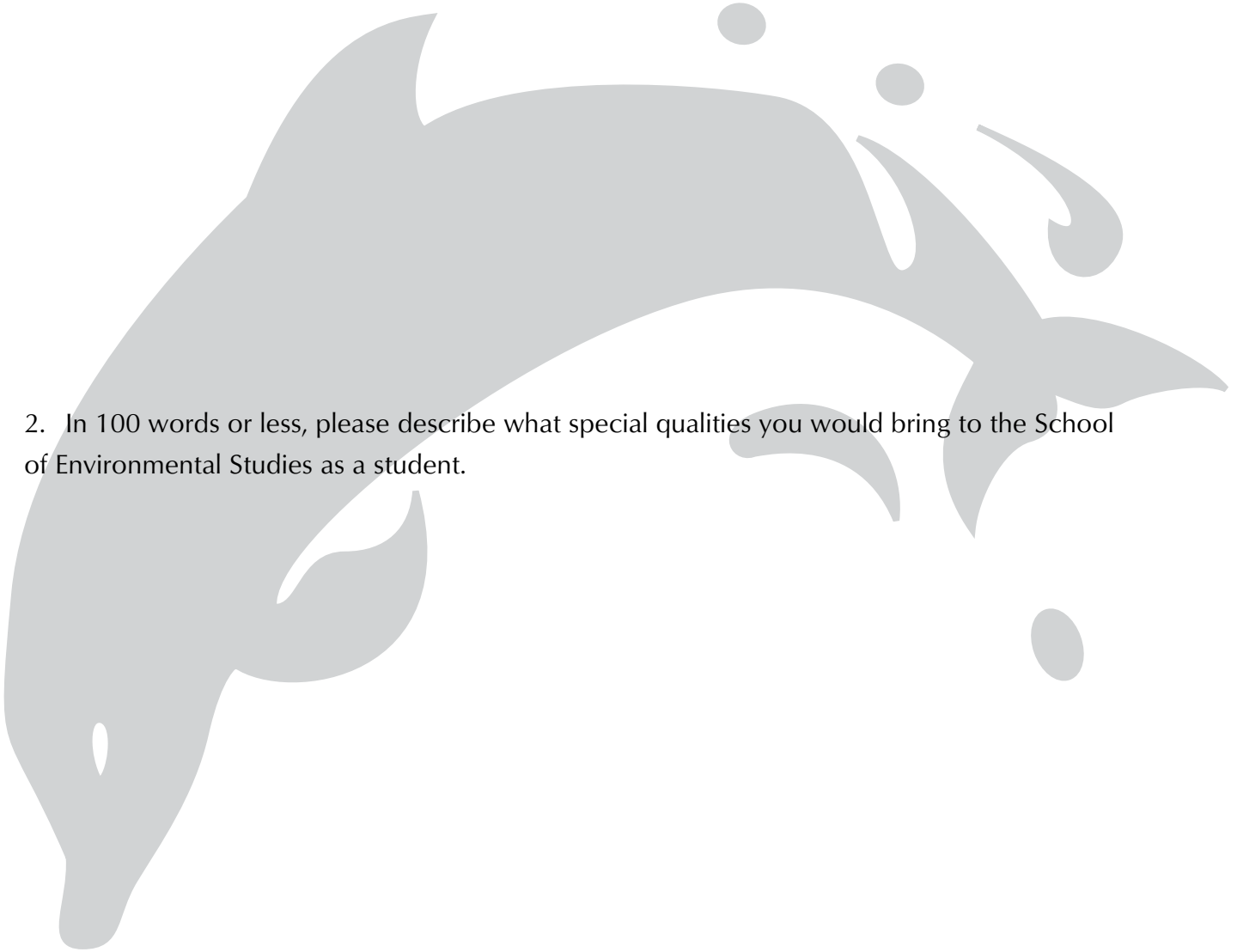
