

Counseling Update

1. Remember that all **trimester 3 schedule changes** must be done by the last day of Tri 2 (March 8). From March 12 through the 16th schedule changes will be allowed only for those students who failed an elective course during 2nd tri, or for seniors who need to meet requirements for graduation (see Mr. Nelson as soon as possible).
